FEED methods & works in progress :

support farms that grow clean, non-GMO food, using certified organic, certified biodynamic, and beyond OG methods

introduce efficient urban distribution methods

transition traditional produce packaging materials, introducing a multi-use bin program to an entire community of 60+ farms, and 85+ buyers

create a proactive food system that mitigates waste simply by helping farms to sell their food

evolve our current organizational structure to allow for a community's self-“ownership” of its food system

partner with like-intentioned organizations to maximize individual and communal efficiency/productivity, whilst inherently minimizing resource usage overlap
